BAIDO (Bay Area International Development Organizations) is the network of San Francisco Bay Area nonprofits doing international development work. We promote understanding of the challenges facing people globally — and the solutions we are finding. BAIDO is the first and only network of its kind in the U.S.

BAIDO members work in almost every developing country on a wide range of issues. As of October 2002, BAIDO was made up of more than 75 organizations, involving thousands of people in Northern California and millions around the world.

The BAIDO network began in the 1990s as an informal group that met to discuss common concerns. Since 2000, BAIDO has become more organized and active. More than 70 dedicated volunteers have offered their time and talents to making BAIDO a success.

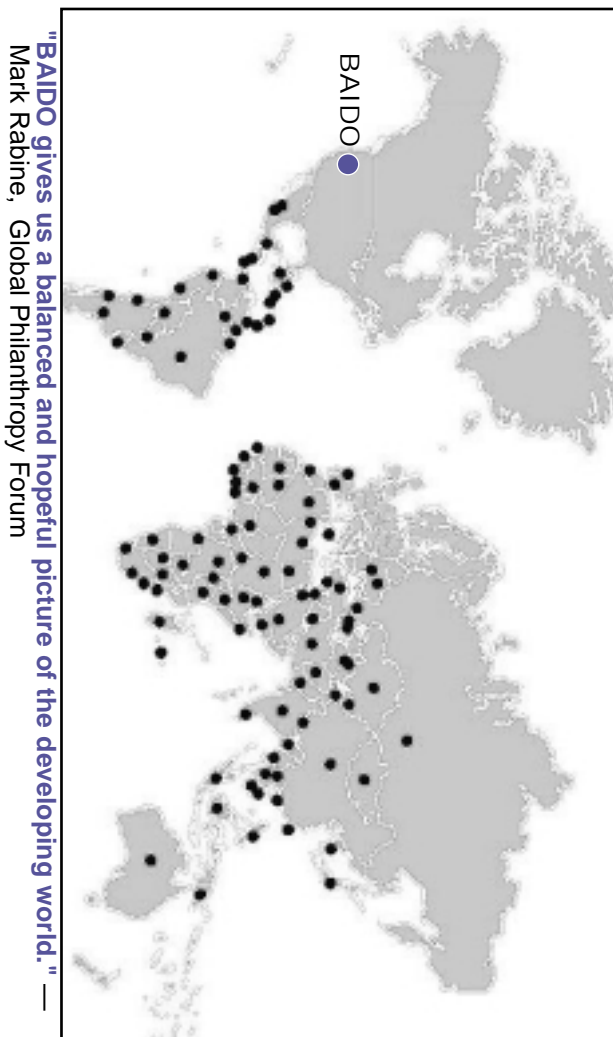
